



Mt Hutt Junior Interfield South Island Championships 28, 29 Sept 2024

Program

Saturday 28 September – Slalom

Sunday 29 September – Giant Slalom

Each race day will be 2 x single run races; separate results for each run.

The schedule or order of events may change due to weather or conditions. This may be announced as late as the morning of the event on the mountain, so athletes need to have both disciplines equipment prepared and available at the mountain.

Eligibility

Open to Snow Sport New Zealand (SSNZ) registered athletes:

U8, U10, U12, U14 & U16.

Please note all athletes must be SSNZ registered, and speed suits are not required, but may be worn.

This race is set to primarily focus on the U8, U10, and U12 athletes.

Entry Fees \$40.00/athlete/day

Registration **Entries close on Wednesday 25 September 2024 @ 3pm.**

Late entries: Any entries after this date and time will be considered late entries. Late entries are at the discretion of the Timer and ROC and if accepted will be subject to a \$100 late entry fee per race, in addition to race entry fees, payable immediately.

Lift tickets

- \$82.50 for Adult (16+)
- \$52.50 for Under 16
- Under 6 years old receives a free lift ticket.





Discounted lift price is for competitors only. Coaches are entitled to a FOC lift pass for every 8 competitors entered. Coaches with less than 8 competitors, or additional coaches, receive a discounted lift pass. Coaches must be a coach of a program recognised by SSNZ. Discounted lift tickets are for race days only.

Passes can be purchased at Guest Services on the mountain in the morning. They can also be purchased at the Methven down town NZ Ski office prior to 4pm. (Note the office shuts at 4pm, so best to go closer to 3pm). Please note that payment must be made in full before any lift passes can be issued and uplifted from Guest Services. Lifts open at 9am for competitors.

(If First Tracks is open then the lift opens at 8am if you have a First Tracks pass. The rates above does not give you access to First Tracks.)

2nd Race may be back to back depending on conditions. If a second inspection is required, then this will be advised on the hill.

Race start time

10.30 am – First race start

2nd race straight after 1st race.

Races will be held on Johnny Doles / skiers left of Broadway. GS start at top of Johnny Doles, SL start part way down.

Prize giving

Saturday: Outside the Mt Hutt Ski Club, approximately 1 hour after the finish of the races.

Sunday: In Methven, at the Samuel's Bar next to the Blue Pub at approximately 4:30 pm.
